VALUE ADDED COURSE: iBizSim BUSINESS SIMULATION

During the academic year 2021-22, Department of Management Studies introduce a course of Business simulation iBizSim for its 1st year MMS students. The business simulation is the hands-on, interactive learning experience that covers all aspects of manufacturing products and marketing them internationally. The simulation used as the core of any specific business course covering Marketing, Operations, Purchasing, Finance, International Business, and/or Strategy and Planning.

Dr. Ashok Ullal, the chief developer of iBizSim simulation has conducted the sessions for students. He is Professor Emiritus and Former Dean, School of International Business, Reutlingen University, Germany. Under this simulation technique students worked with the company, which was depicted as a complex, integrated whole, comprised of the different divisions and departments working together in well-defined ways. It was a learning-by-doing tool in which teams of students were given the responsibility to manage a simulated company.

iBizSim carries distinguishing and unique phase structure, that helped in evaluating student learning of business processes throughout the semester. Phase I was the learning phase in which the students explored and understand the simulated environment, the management of the simulated company and the user interface to the business simulation. During Phase 2 which was the preparatory and analysis phase in which the student teams were encouraged to develop an integrated planning model using a spreadsheet program by cross-linking the individual templates for the marketing and sales plan, the production plan, the purchasing plan and the finance plan. Phase 3 was the doing phase in which the students started with a new opening situation. Phase 4 was the phase when the final learning through reflection took place.

It was indeed one of the happy learning experience of students for building skills, improve conceptual knowledge, and gain a big picture view of the organization all at once.



SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME: STUDENT EXPERIENCES

The MMS batch of 2022 completed their First Semester exams and headed off to their internships which began in the month of May and was for a term of two months. Though internships are usually undertaken after the completion of the first academic year (after two semesters), this year was an exception since the academic year started in January 2022. The Placement Committee of the department played key role in placing students helped with the placement of many of the students of the batch, who went on to complete their internships successfully in the duration of the next 2-3 months. Here are the experiences of some of our students:





"I am working in Navi Technologies in Bengaluru as a Customer Research Intern. This internship proved to be a new and exciting experience for me. I worked on the various methodologies that are used for research to arrive at a solution for a business problem. I understood the importance of having the research department as an integral part of the business processes, since it gives room for feedback and improvement. Connecting directly with the end users gave important insights and helped to target their pain points, which further helped to provide solutions for the same and improve the overall app experience for the users. Being a part of many of the ongoing projects gave me insights on teamwork and accountability.

Most importantly, the healthy work environment with perfect work-life balance helped me to be consistent with my contributions and kept me stress-free. Being an intern at Navi Technologies gave me the experience of an ideal workplace and helped me with a correct attitude towards corporate life. Process involves stages from the sales lead generation in Odoo to manufacturing and dispatching of product from plant.

Furthermore, I worked on inventory management where I implemented Odoo barcode technology, as it gives an advantage by reducing human errors and providing a clear picture about the inventory. I also got an opportunity to work on Odoo dashboard, It helps to generate different types of production and sales report so higher management get an overall view of plant performance on weekly, monthly and quarterly basis.



I gained deeper insights into the manufacturing industry, and it has helped me significantly with my career planning. I developed a better understanding of the career path of an Operation manager through the internship, helping me to make an informed career decision."
